The NETS program shall provide employment counseling and financial support to Nak'azdli members.

SPECIFIC: to set a specific goal you must answer the six "W" question: Who, What, Where, When, Which, Why.

MEASURABLE: to determine if your goal is measureable, ask questions such as; How will I know it is accomplished.

ACHEIVABLE: you can achieve your goals you set when you plan your steps wisely and establish a time frame that allows you to carry out those steps.

REALISTIC: to be realistic, a goal must represent an objective towards which you are both willing and able to work towards.

TIMELY: a goal should have time lines, when do you want to accomplish your goals.

What NETS provides

NETS will provide employment services to Aboriginal clients for skill development opportunities to those that are currently on Social Assistance or EI eligible. NETS provides pre-employment counseling; on the job training and/or course purchase.

Our focus is on Skills Development training opportunities for unemployed and under employed clients. We also provide career development exercises, action plan referrals and work experience.



PROGRAM SERVICES

To provide clients with access to training intervention leading to employment and/or to certification required for industry based employment.

PROGRAM ROASTER

NETS provides the following programs in partnership with PGNAETA.

WORK/SAFETY GEAR: is designed to assist with a one time only gear, to individuals starting a new job. You will need to submit a letter of employment and price quote to qualify.

COURSE PURCHASE: for short or long term course purchase, meet with NETS Manager to find out if you qualify for this program. You are required to submit a letter of acceptance, complete an action plan, confirmation of cost for the course, and complete a labour market survey.

MOBILITY: This one time only funds is for individuals needing travel assistance to move to another location for employment purposes.

YOUTH INITIATIVE: Is designed to provide wage subsidy to help youth gain valuable employment skills. NETS provides summer employment positions; Aboriginal Community Enhancement and Youth Empowerment Strategy initiatives to provide youth with necessary skills leading to employment and career development.
