# **S-100 Training and Recertification**

## **S-100 May 8-9, Recert May 8**

Upon successful completion of the course, the candidate will demonstrate a basic knowledge of wildland fire suppression organization structure, wild fire behavior, and suppression and safety procedures.

- Practical skills with equipment used in BC to effectively and safely respond to wildfires is a mandatory component for initial ticket holders.
- For industry workers who may be required to take fire control as outlined to the Wildfire Act and Regulations (loggers, truck drivers etc.).
- Annual certification is mandatory.
- The S-100 is a two day, 16-hour course with both a classroom and a field component.
