informed Consent and Acknowledgement

I hereby give my approval for my child's participation in any and all activities prepared by Nak'azdli Whut'en during the selected camp. In exchange for the acceptance of the said child's candidacy by Nak'azdli Whut'en, I assume all risk and hazards incidental to the conduct of the activities and release, absolve and hold harmless Nak'azdli Whut'en, and all its staff, volunteers and representatives of any and all liability for injuries to said child arising out of traveling to, participating in, or returning from camp. In case of injury to said child, I hereby waive all claims against Nak'azdli Whut'en, including their staff and affiliates, all participants, volunteers, and if applicable, owners and lessors of the premises used to conduct camping and activities. There is a risk of being injured that is inherent in all physical activities, including swimming. Some of these injuries include, but are not limited to, the risk of fractures, paralysis, or death.

Medical Release and Authorization

As Parent and/or Guardian of the named camper, I hereby authorize the diagnosis and treatment by a qualified and licensed medical professional, of the minor child, in the event of a medical emergency, which in the opinion of the attending medical professional, requires immediate attention to prevent further endangerment of the minor's life, physical disfigurement, physical impairment, or other undue pain, suffering or discomfort, if delayed.

Permission is hereby granted to the attending physician to proceed with any medical or minor surgical treatment, x-ray examination and immunizations for the named child. In the event of an emergency arising out of serious illness, the need for major surgery, or significant accidental injury, I understand that every attempt will be made by the attending physician to contact me in the most expeditious way possible. This authorization is granted only after a reasonable effort has been made to reach me.

Permission is also granted to Nak'azdli Whut'en and its affiliates including Management, Staff, and Volunteers to provide the needed emergency treatment prior to the child's admission to the medical facility.

This release is authorized and executed of my own free will, with the sole purpose of authorizing medical treatment under emergency circumstances, for the protection of life and limb of the named minor child, in my absence.

Camper's Code of Conduct

Please review with your child prior to July 31, 2023

The staff/volunteers are looking forward to providing all our campers with a fun, memorable, and safe summer camp experience. Each camper has a responsibility to act in a way that assures a positive experience for all. All campers are required to follow these guidelines

Behaviour Guidelines

- Campers shall be responsible for their words and actions.
- Campers shall be respectful of others.
- Campers shall follow directions from staff members at all times.
- Campers shall leave all electronic devices at home such as iPods, handheld computer games, MP3 players. Cell phones brought to camp are the responsibility of the child and only used in emergencies.
- Campers shall not venture off with other campers in the evenings or during the daytime without notifying a staff member.
- Campers are forbidden to enter any other cabin they are not assigned to.
- Possession or use of drugs, alcohol, and/or tobacco while attending camp is prohibited, and will result in immediate dismissal.

Prohibited Behaviours

- Foul or disrespectful language towards staff or fellow campers.
- Failure to adhere to staff's direction/behaviour guidelines and rules.
- Misuse of cellphones, iPad etc. (This includes using these devices outside of the allotted device handling time sectioned off during the day).
- Reckless behaviour that could result in physical/emotional harm to themselves, fellow campers or staff.
- Misuse of any property that could result in broken equipment/facilities

Steps taken for failure to follow these behaviour guidelines

- Staff will redirect the camper to more appropriate behaviour.
- The camper will be reminded of the behaviour guidelines.
- If the behaviour persists, staff will discuss the problem with a parent/guardian.
- The staff will document the situation. The written documents will include what the behaviour problem is, what provoked the problem, and the corrective action is taken.
- If the problem persists to the point where a second phone call becomes necessary, the Camp Director may find it necessary to have the camper picked up early from camp.
- If a camper's behaviour at any time threatens the immediate safety of him/her, other campers, or staff, the parent/guardian will be notified and expected to pick up the child immediately.
