The role of the design consultant is to facilitate the process so that this goal can be achieved.


WHAT IS YOUR CONNECTION WITH THE LAND?

FORMAT


• The second community activity involved printing images representing important cultural practices, historical events, or other significant aspects of the community's identity.


WHAT SPACES AND **EVENTS SHOULD** TAKE PLACE IN THE **BUILDING?**




WHAT THE BUILDING SHOULD LOOK AND FEEL LIKE?

FORMAT


· Participants were asked to respond to images of differrent building forms by placing sticky notes on the ones that resonated with them, or leaving comments on what they liked or didn't like.

The priorities and values of Dakelh community that arise at these events will become the foundational principles of the design process for the Cultural Building.




CONSULTATION OUTCOMES: ADMIN & CULTURAL BUILDING

The feedback recieved at the October 2022 consultation resulted in some fundamental shifts in the approach to both the administration and cultural buildings.



















INITIAL CONCEPT


- Administration Building and Cultural Building attached by shared lobby.
- One big building with separate programs.
- Shared lobby useful as public interior space, ease of access, and wayfinding.





BREAK

- Administration Building and Cultural Building are separated into two buildings.
- The two lobbies are adjacent to one another for ease of access and wayfinding on the site.





NEW APPROACH

- First steps were taken to form a Cultural Advisory Committee that would lead the community engagement process.
- An art and Culture Coordinator position was created to manage the integration of Dakelh Artwork in the buildings and to act as chair of the Cultural Advisory Committee.
